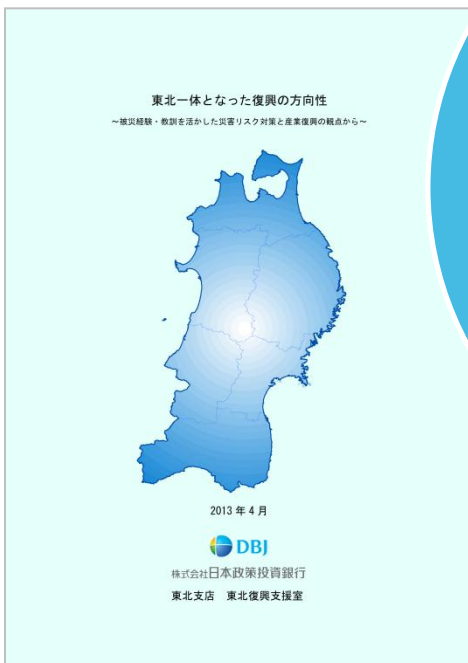

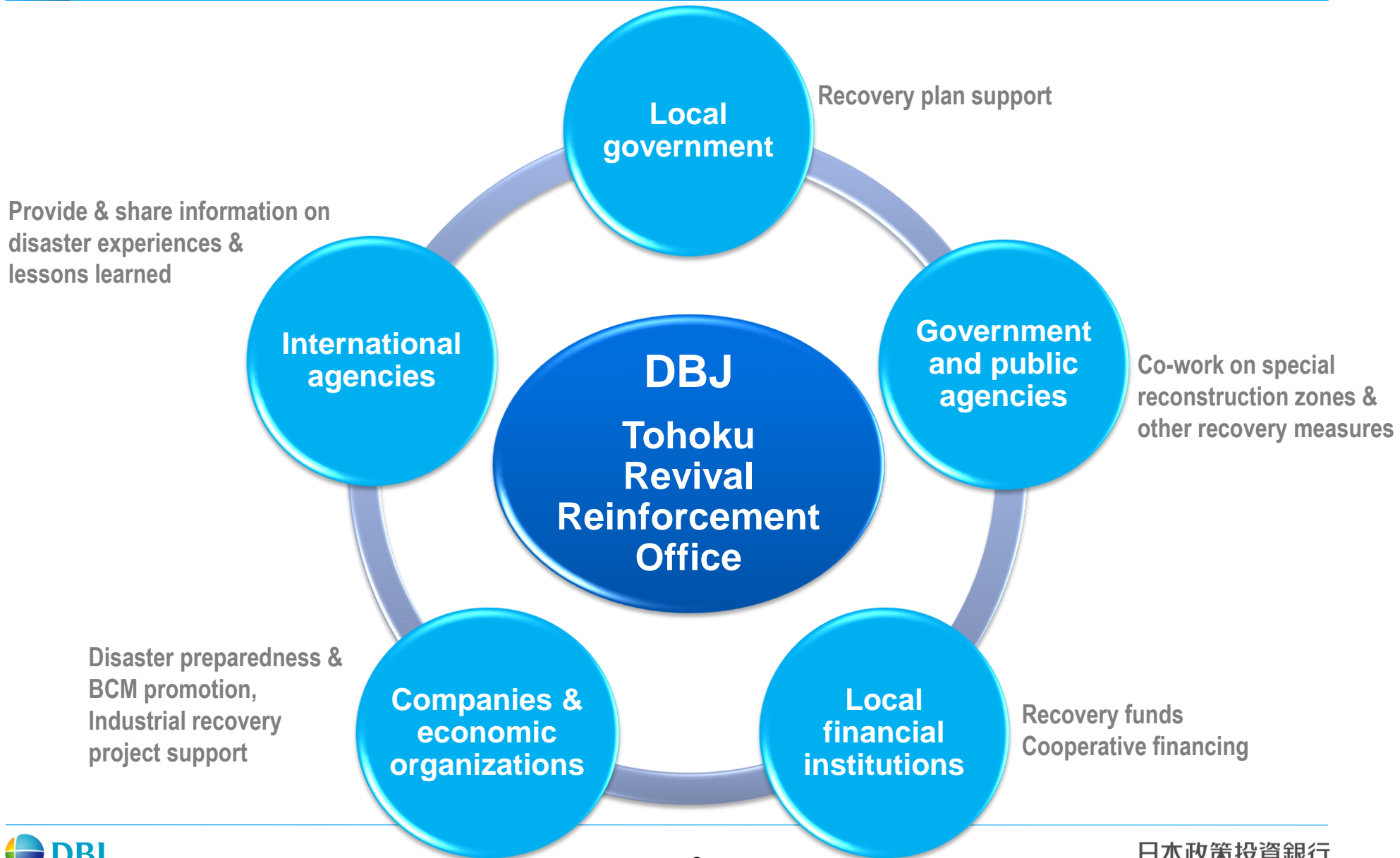

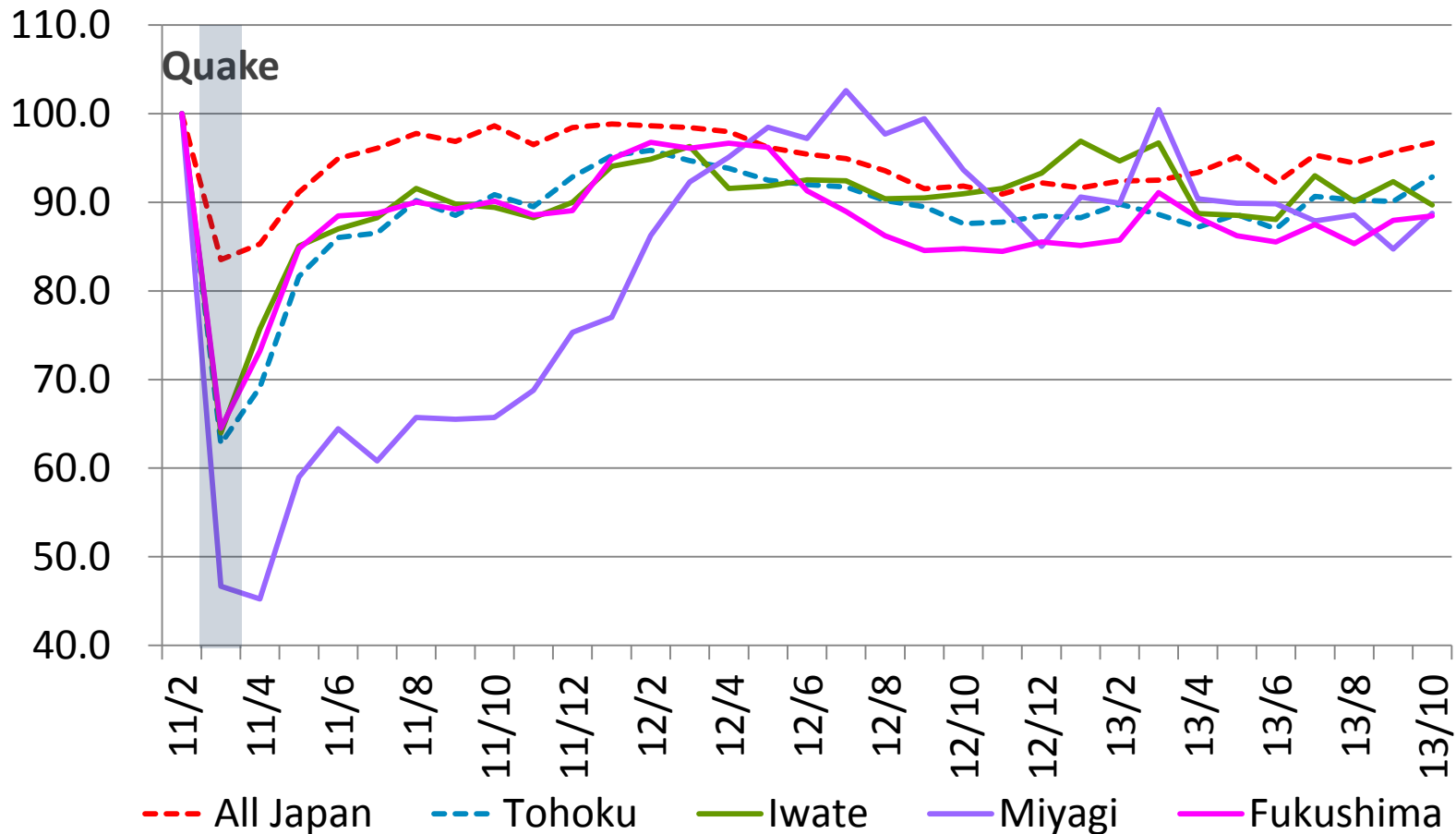

◆ Mining & manufacturing production indexes (pre-quake = 100)

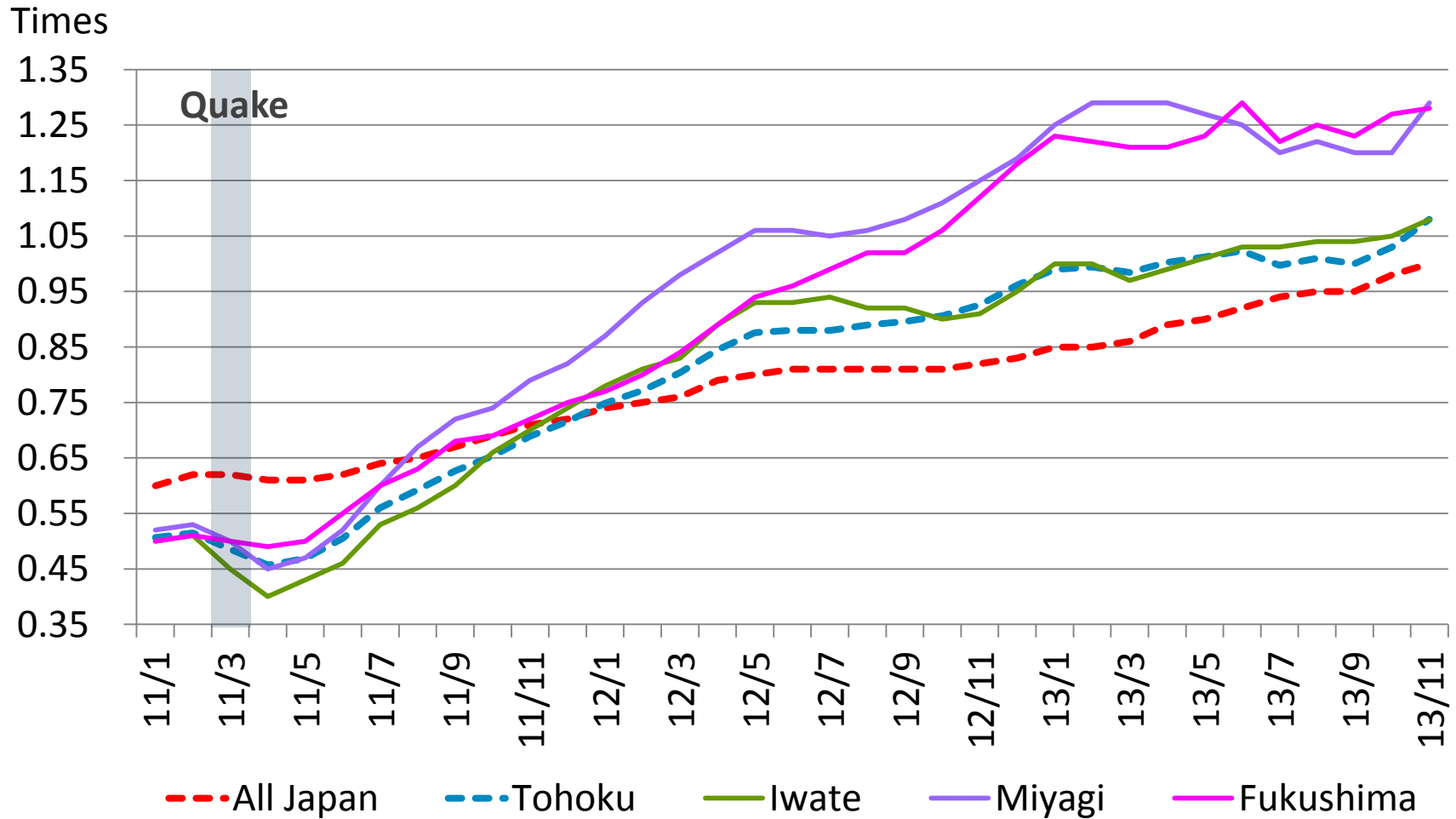

◆ Jobs-to-Applicants Ratio

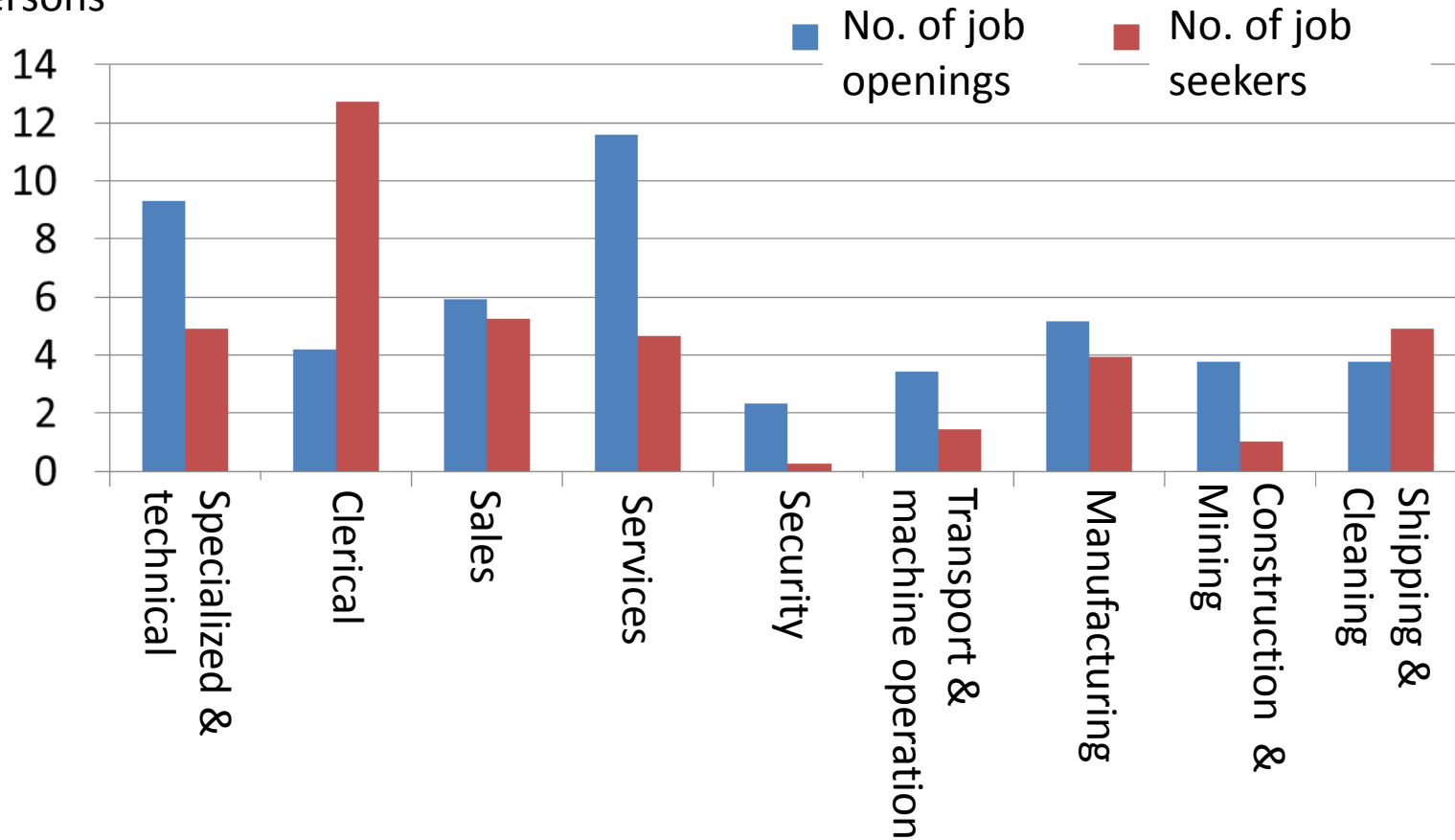

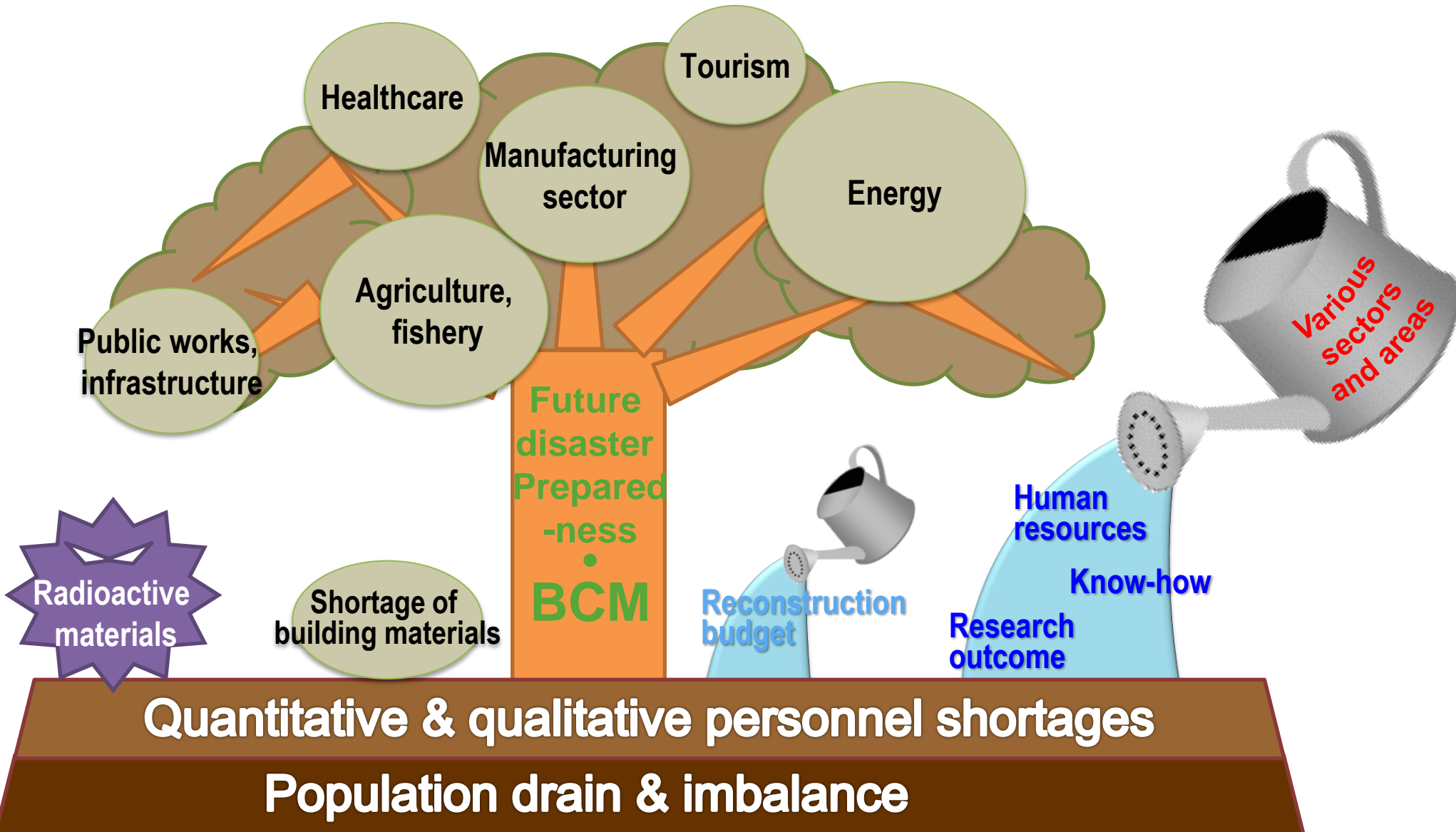
◆ Number of job offers & job seekers by occupation (Miyagi Prefecture, Nov. 2013)

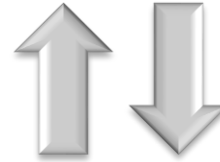

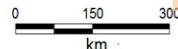

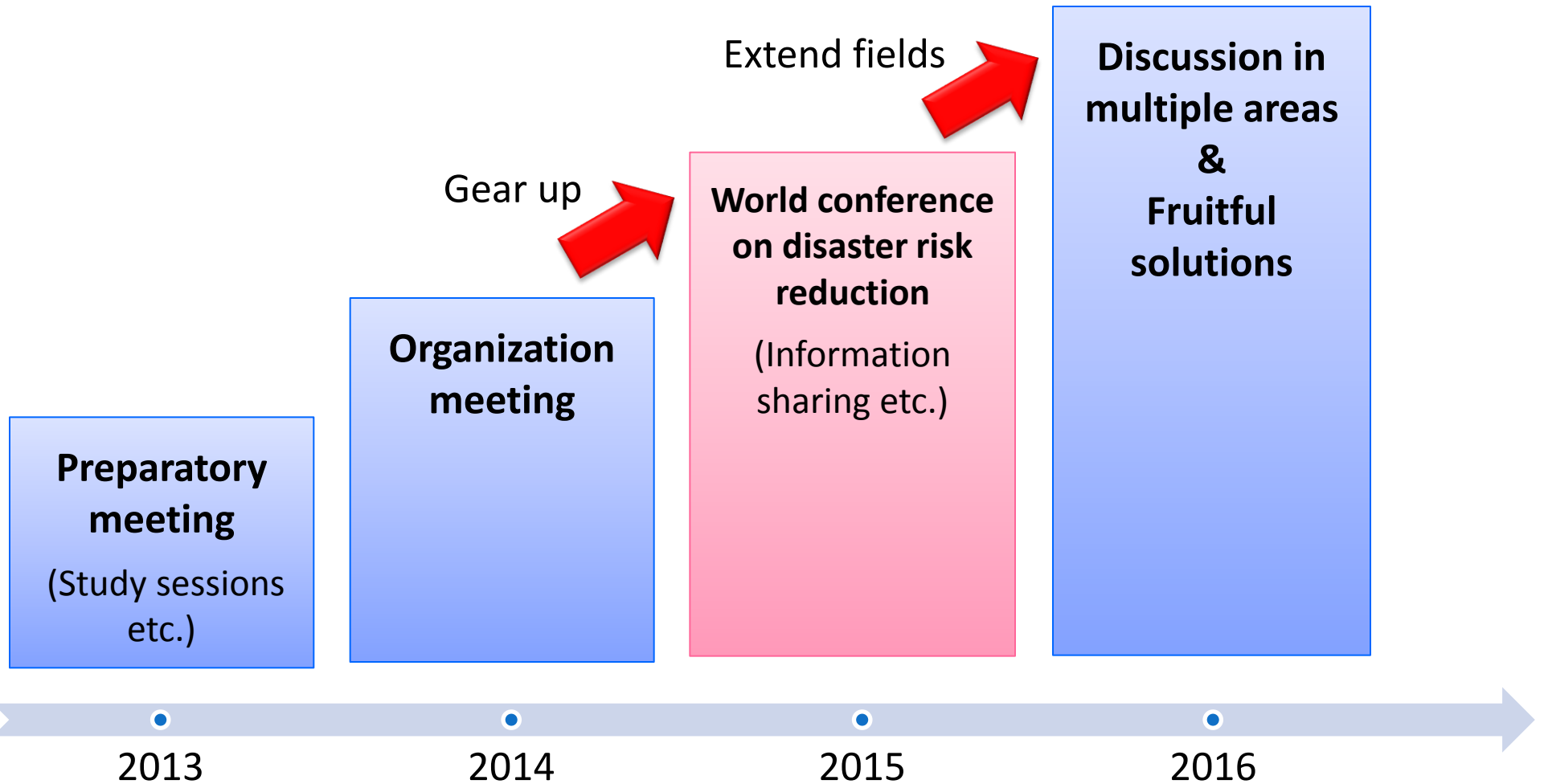
